The Waikato Building Consent Group (WBCG) is a collaborative cluster of eight councils in the Waikato region.

The Group was set up in 2004 to establish a consistent, best-practice approach to building control functions in the Waikato.

We achieve this through shared quality assurance systems, collaboration, consistency in building control functions and providing a regional voice on industry issues.

## WHAT WE DO

- We increase collaboration and communication between Building Consent Authorities (BCAs).
- We facilitate regional submissions on legislative changes, representing a unified voice at the central government level.
- We provide a group Quality Assurance System and documentation.
- We provide BCA support during IANZ Accreditation Assessments.
- We identify and coordinate regional training opportunities for cost-effective and consistent professional development.
- We manage both the Producer Statement author and IQP registers and application process.
- We provide the application resources to assist customers in applying for building consent with their local council.

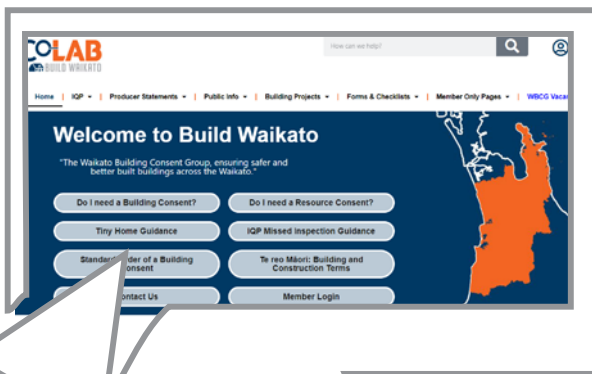
## HOW WE CAN HELP YOU
